Discuss what an algorithm is with your family.

### Super Skills:

Write a set of algorithms for your family to follow.

Design your own program to move yourself or a toy to another place.

### Knitted Knowledge:

Explain what jealousy is. Discuss a time when you have felt jealous.

### Super Skills:

Share with your family a happy memory you have that helps you to cope when times are hard.
