Outdoor Area Development

As you will know from previous letters, we are currently trying to raise funds to develop our outdoor area and perhaps replace some of the equipment that was removed over the Summer. We estimate that we will need around £20,000 in order to do this! In September we completed an application for a lottery grant towards this project. Last week we had the good news that our bid was successful and we have been awarded the fantastic amount of £10,000! We are thrilled to say the least! Along with this and the very generous donations that have started to come in from local businesses over the last few weeks, we are making great progress towards our target – thank you to everyone who has donated so far. Clearly we do still have some way to go, so if you, or somebody you know, may be interested in getting involved in our project, please do get in touch and I will be more than happy to discuss this.

Air Ambulance Collection

We have spare bags at the office for anyone can fill an extra bag, or you can use black bin bags as additional bags. For anyone else who would like to get involved we are collecting gifts until 14 December; these can include selection boxes, sweets, toys, games, smellies, socks and underwear, hats, scarves and gloves.
