Areas of Learning

As writers: we will focus on using accurate spelling using strategies to support us.

We will be focusing on a range of sentence types and aiming to use these consistently in our writing. We will be looking to extend our vocabulary and be aware of the reader when we write.

As readers: we will be focussing on using our skills of inference and deductions when reading texts, and increasing our speed by practising skimming and scanning.

As mathematicians: we will extend our knowledge of place value. We will use the four rules in context, revising strategies where necessary. We will extend this to include fractions and decimals.

As computer experts: we will learn how to make a stop motion animation and use this to help us improve our story writing skills. We will continue to use ICT to record our thinking and findings.

Wellbeing

We will be developing our emotional literacy, taking time to discuss our feelings and consider different ways of coping in challenging circumstances.

We will be looking at how we can play a supportive role to others and how we can gain strength from those around us.

Understanding the World

We will focus on understanding how our actions have consequences and how this can impact on others. We will look at how people interact and our place within the world.

We will consider risks and learn to make calculated risks. We will also aim to learn from our own and others mistakes.

We will refine our fine motor skills and select our tools purposefully.

We will be cutting and measuring materials accurately, aiming to reduce waste focussing on area, length and perimeter.

We will also be drawing and describing 2D shapes and creating 3D shapes using our knowledge of shape properties as well as using correct mathematical terminology.
