Areas of Learning

English – we will be developing our phonics, reading and writing skills through fairy tales, beginning with ‘The Three Bears’.

Maths - we will be learning about Numbers and Place Value.

Science - we will be learning about parts of the human body and ‘The 5 Senses’.

Geography - we will be learning about ‘Our Local Area’.

Art - we will be investigating the primary colours.

Computers -we will be developing our computer skills and we will be using computers to support our learning, using ‘Lexia’ and ‘Mathletics’.

Music - we will focus our learning around a Hip-Hop song for children!

PE – we will be developing our gymnastic skills, focusing in particular on rolls.

RE – we will be thinking about ‘How Christians show that they are thankful at Harvest’. Collective Worship will focus on ‘The Rainbow’.

We will be exploring mindfulness through basic yoga techniques and meditation.

Through different types of play, active, and experiential learning opportunities as well as practical activities, children will be provided with meaningful experiences. These will stimulate their senses as well as encourage them to ask questions, explore and wonder at their environment. They will undertake investigations that engage their interests, and develop awareness of the beliefs and views of others.

Creative Arts

We will be exploring the seasonal changes, through various art activities.

We will be exploring ‘Road Safety’ through a ‘Pyjama Drama’ session.

We will use problem-solving investigations within every unit to encourage children to develop and exercise their ability to reason mathematically and think creatively. The investigations will provide challenges that offer opportunities for the development of the key maths skills while deepening conceptual understanding.
