



# Y4 Autumn 1

### Areas of Learning

**As Readers:** We will be reading Charlie and the Chocolate Factory in guided reading and working on developing our vocabulary to support our writing. We will also be working on our inference skills to pick up on hidden messages and making sure that we can find the key parts of the text to answer questions.

**As Writers:** We will be looking at non-chronological reports as a means of presenting factual information. We will also be developing our understanding of various characters through some powerful character descriptions.

**As Mathematicians:** We will be focusing on place value and being able to read, write, order and compare 3- and 4-digit words. We will also be developing our addition, subtraction multiplication and division skills. We will develop also be practicing our times tables throughout.

**As Scientists:** We will be taking a closer look at both the digestive system and the mouth, noting the functions of the various parts. We will be looking at food chains and the role of producers, predators and prey within these chains.

**R.E:** We will be looking at what Christians and Muslims understand about the need for thankfulness in their lives.

**As Historians:** We will be taking a look at Carlisle Castle and its history in our local area.

**Computing:** We will be developing our understanding of multimedia and word processing, creating documents and Power Points.

**As Geographers:** We will be focusing on the location of countries on a map, taking a closer look at various countries in detail.

**As Athletes:** We will be working on our running, jumping, throwing and catching skills in isolation and using them together in small competitive games.

### Wellbeing

We will be exploring mindfulness techniques. Also thinking about what we can do to control negative thoughts and feelings.

We will be looking at the skills we need to work together effectively with others and applying these to our work in other subjects.

### Understanding the World

We will be looking at the 'Picture the News' resources to help us understand what is happening in the news.

We will be developing our understanding of different religions to help us recognise the diversity in our community.

### Creative Arts

We will be working on our drawing skills including using different pencils to show line, tone and texture. Using shading to show light and shadow and hatching and cross hatching to show tone and texture.

### Maths in context

We will be using our Maths skills of place value in context to help us read and compare numbers up to four digits and beyond.

We will apply our Maths skills to real life problems and use them to help us in Science investigations.
