Practise doing up your buttons on your school shirt, cardigan, trousers etc.	What words can you write with the sounds we have learnt so far?	How many Christmas trees can you count on a walk?
Practise doing up your winter coat.	Design a poster about how to keep safe on Bonfire Night.	Can you make a Christmas decoration for our tree in class?
Can you get dressed independently for school?	Go on a 'Shape Hunt'. Name the shapes you can find when you go out on a walk e.g. square window.	Can you remember a Christmas joke? It must be good enough to go inside a cracker!
