"The fundamental British values of democracy, rule of law, individual liberty, mutual respect and tolerance for those with different faiths and beliefs are implicitly embedded in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS)."

- Clear routines and consistency (visual timetable, rewards)
- Respecting personal boundaries (visual symbols of good sitting etc., role play, modelling)
- Tools are taught and are available to aid self-regulation (explicit teaching JIGSAW, social stories)
- Giving children choice and individual liberty (develop and explore own interests, book voting, risk taking in outdoor environment)
- Following rules and expectations (School behaviour expectations)
- Respectful role models (communicating clearly, modelling behaviour, praising effort)
- Tolerance of different faiths and beliefs (Religion and World Views, celebrate cultural events, books)
- Giving consent to apply first aid, change wet clothes (PANTS rule)
- Have the chance to voice opinions (circle time, show and tell)
