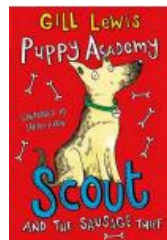

Storybooks

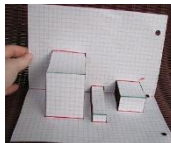
Scan the code to learn how to make a moving picture
