Please remember to sign your child's reading record when you hear them read. We will check them weekly in school and award a Dalston Dollar point if they have read at least 4 times in a week.

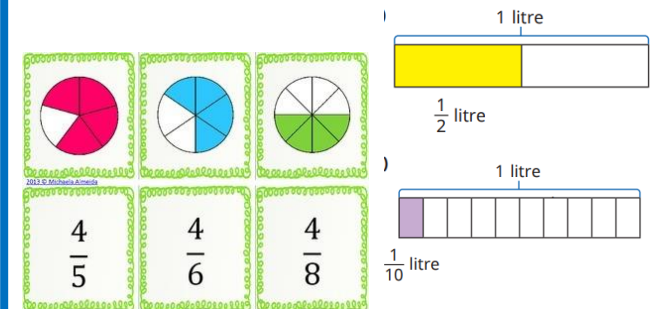

### Animals including humans:

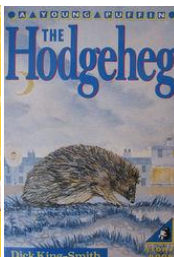
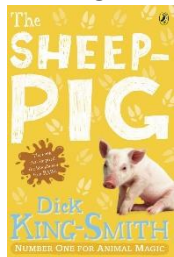
- We will learn how animals and humans need the right amounts of nutrition and that they cannot make their own food.
