

## Home Learning 2

The following information sets out some of our plans to provide continuing learning materials to our children in the event of a school closure. Please read it alongside “Home Learning 1” which sets out activities available in the case of self-isolation (these activities will still be appropriate in the event of school closure). Additionally, in the event that schools close, we are in the process of setting up a section of the school website where staff will upload work for the children to complete while they are at home. This section will be available under “Kids” and “Home Learning”, but will only be available in the event of a whole school closure.

### Reading

We will be sending home extra reading books and, in some cases, picture books with all children. Please see “Home Learning 1” for details of sites which offer free e-books and audio books. Some classes may also have additional sheets with key words or sounds to learn or practise.

### Mathletics

In the event of a whole school closure, your child’s class teacher will be posting specific tasks for them to complete. These tasks will appear on their home screen when they log in to the program.

### White CGP Maths books

All children from Y1-Y6 have a white maths book which they will bring home in the event of a whole school closure. These books focus on arithmetic and are designed to be quite challenging. Children may need your support with some of the questions.

### NumBots

A great maths site with many different games and activities. In the event of school closure, the site will be offering partial free access to resources.

### BBC Bitesize

This is an older site but still has many excellent activities, videos and games covering many areas of the curriculum.

### Twinkl

This is a site which offers all sorts of resources for education, mainly printouts. There is usually a fee for using the site. However, Twinkl are offering a month of free access to parents and school staff in the event of school closures.
