Reading

SCIENCE

Knitted Knowledge:

Explain how an instrument creates different pitches

Super Skills:

Invent your own instrument and explain how it works. Can you make it change pitch and volume?



RELIGION AND WORLDVIEWS

How is the big story of the Bible?

- Can you tell me what the Bible says about creation?
- Who went against God in the Bible and what did they do?
- Can you tell me what happened when Jesus was born?
- Tell me about a story Jesus told (parable) and what he was trying to teach people.

COMPUTING

Knitted Knowledge:

How many types of media do you know that can be shared online?

Super Skills:

Discuss why it is important to be careful with the information we share online.

HISTORY

Knitted Knowledge:

Find out some facts about the Ancient Egyptians to create your own timeline.

Super Skills:

Research the Ancient Egyptians using a range of books – you may like to visit the library.



PE

Knitted Knowledge:

How many rolls can you name?

Super Skills:

Perform your own gymnastic routine incorporating balances, rolls, turns and jumps.

FRENCH

Knitted Knowledge:

Name animals in French.

Super skill:

Describe an animal using colour.

PSHE

Knitted Knowledge:

Discuss why teamwork is important for learning.

Super Skills:

Analyse why an argument has happened. What might you do differently next time?

MUSIC

Super Skills:

Learn the songs for the Nativity and perform them for members of your family.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

Knitted Knowledge:

Explore a range of Christmas Stockings and decorations and explain what makes them effective.

Super Skills:

Practise sewing a range of stitches. Impress everyone by threading a needle!
