Make links with what they already know, have experienced and are able to do.

### Super Skills:

Discuss what you think about the photos. Do you think it's ok for celebrities to adjust their appearance? What are the pros and cons of doing this?

### Knitted Knowledge:

Explain what resilience is. Discuss a time when you have shown resilience.

### Super Skills:

Set yourself a new year's challenge and set out steps you will take to achieve it.
