

St. Michael's Homework - Class 1 Summer 2 2018

All homework is split into two sections. Section A is compulsory homework which should be completed each week. Section B is "choices" homework. This half term children should choose at least 3 boxes from Section B to complete. Once they have completed them please sign and date the box. "Choices" may require your child to bring something into school, to find out about something or to take part in something. Each class will have a special board to display anything the children have completed linked to homework and we would encourage them to bring samples in. "Choices" are generally linked to the class topic or science learning that they are currently involved in.

This is very much aimed at making homework purposeful and using it as a tool to support their learning in school. Have fun and be creative!

Write a prayer to say thanks for something to display in our class reflective corner.	Have a go at the cress seed experiment we have done in class. Sow some seeds on cotton wool: place one in the dark with water, another in light with no water and another in the light with water. Record what happens.	Choose one of the countries that are playing in the World Cup and find it on a map. See if you can find out some facts about it and make an information sheet or booklet.
Have a look at the cheese in the supermarket. See if you can find out where they are from. Try a cheese you have not tried before and write about it.	Pick a food and find out where it comes from. Make a booklet or information sheet about it.	Have a go at making your own ice lollies. Take some pictures to show me.
Practise skipping, egg and spoon and potato race for sports day.	A packet of seeds cost 20p. How many different ways can you make 20p using different coins? Write out the sums or use a wax crayon to rub over the coins.	Design and make something to go in your garden e.g. paint a plant pot, make a windmill or a decoration.
