List 3 things that you would really miss if you were to go and live in the rainforest and why.	Go for a walk and collect rock/fossils to show to the class and talk about what they are.
Design an outfit for a rainforest explorer. Would they need any special tools or gadgets?	Research a volcano. Produce a poster e.g. Mount Vesuvius.	Plant a tree in your garden. (Remember to take a photograph)
