As readers we will use inference and deduction to get a greater understanding of books we read Use our knowledge of root words to ascertain the meaning of unfamiliar words.

As writers we will develop a cursive handwriting style. We will use basic punctuation consistently checking that our writing is in the correct tense throughout.

As computer experts we will create our own short films using Scratch

As geographers we will identify and describe how the physical features affect the human activity within a location. Use a range of geographical resources to give detailed descriptions and opinions of the characteristic features of a location.
